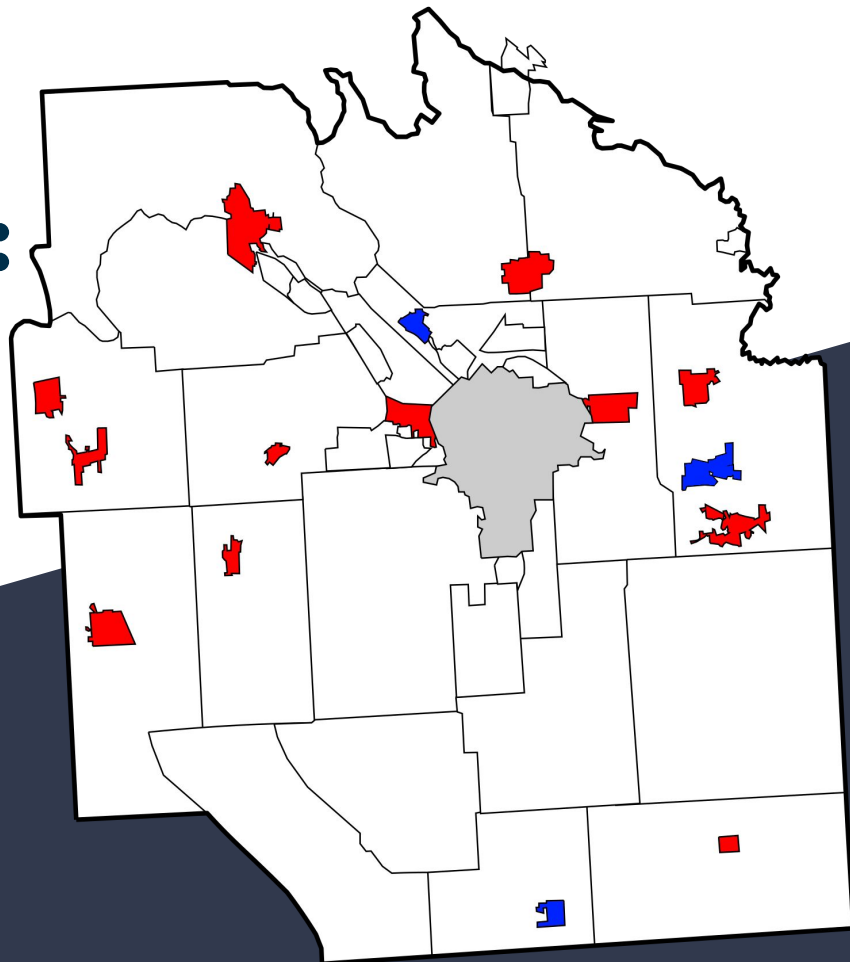

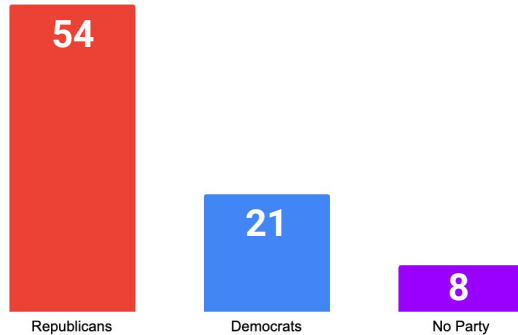

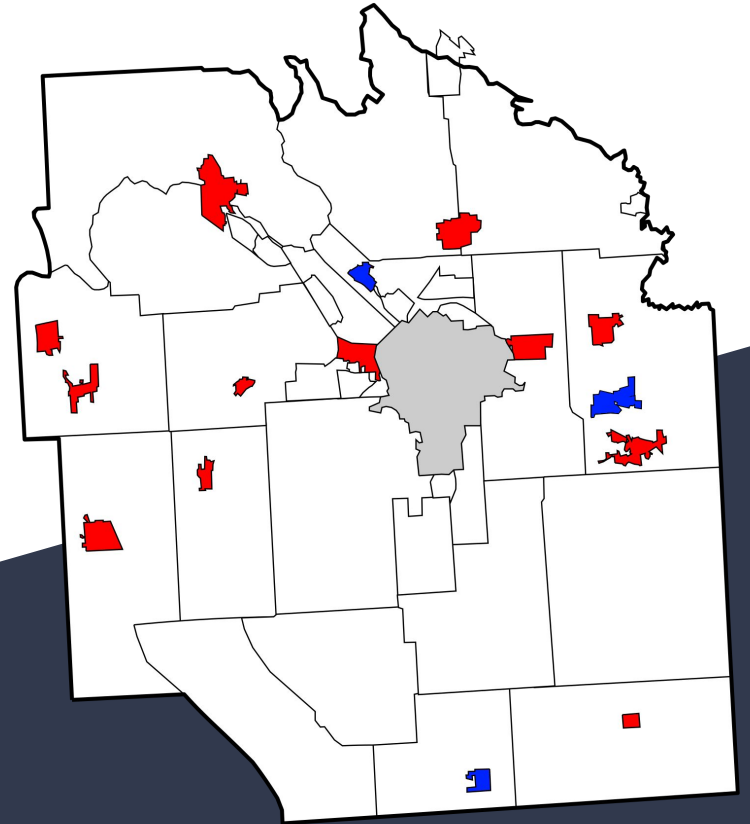


Key Takeaways for 2024:

- Republicans are the majority in 12 out of 15 villages. Democrats are in the majority in Fayetteville, Liverpool and Tully.
- **Village Elections are Partisan.** There are 83 elected positions in Onondaga County villages. Republicans hold 65%, Democrats hold 25% of those seats, and 10% are not registered in a party.



- Of those 83 positions, 28% are held by women.
- Between 2021 - 2024 women gained 2 seats in the villages and Democrats gained a total of 7 seats.

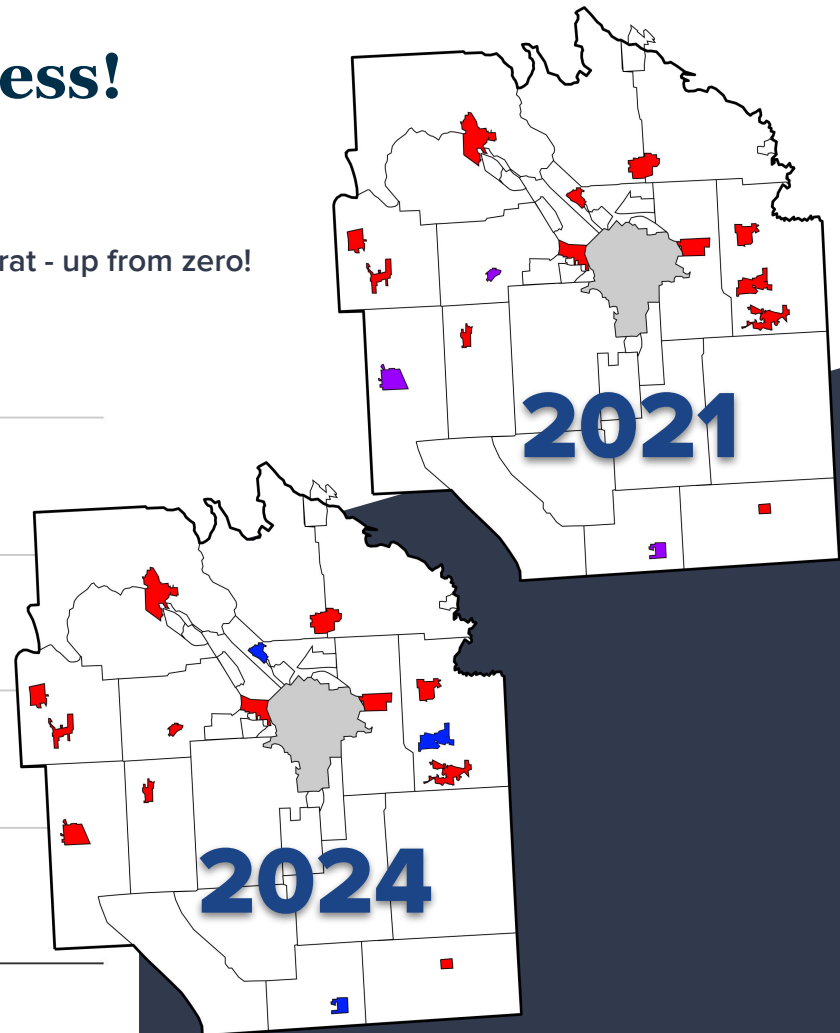
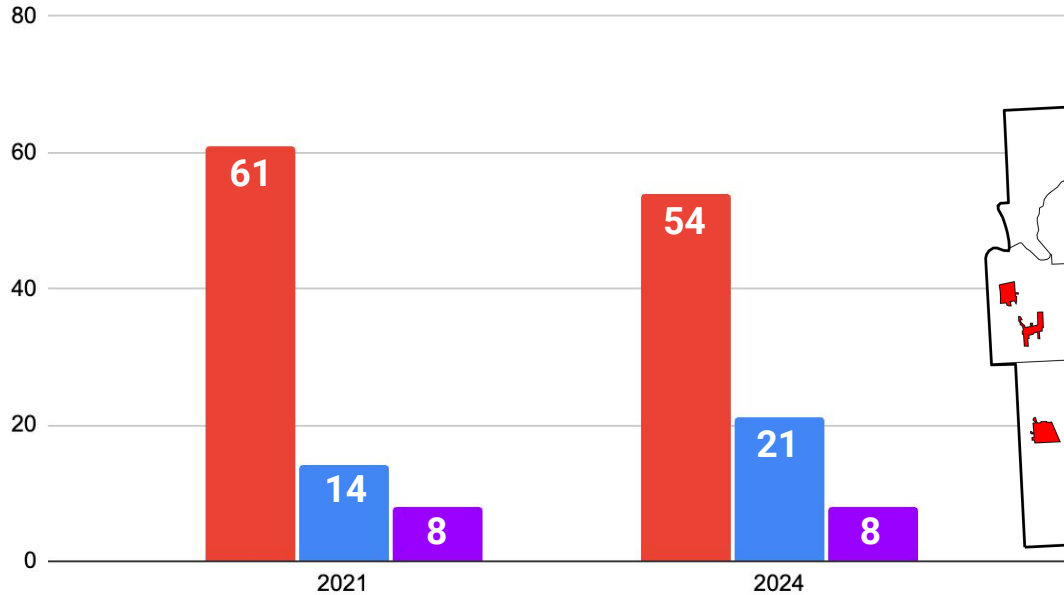


Democrats are making progress!

- Between 2021 - 2024 Democrats gained a total of 7 seats!
- 20% of villages in Onondaga County are now majority Democrat - up from zero!

Village Elections

When are Village Elections held?

- 8 of the 15 villages in Onondaga County are held in March. (green)
- 2 are held in June: Liverpool & North Syracuse. (pink)
- 5 are held in November. (orange)

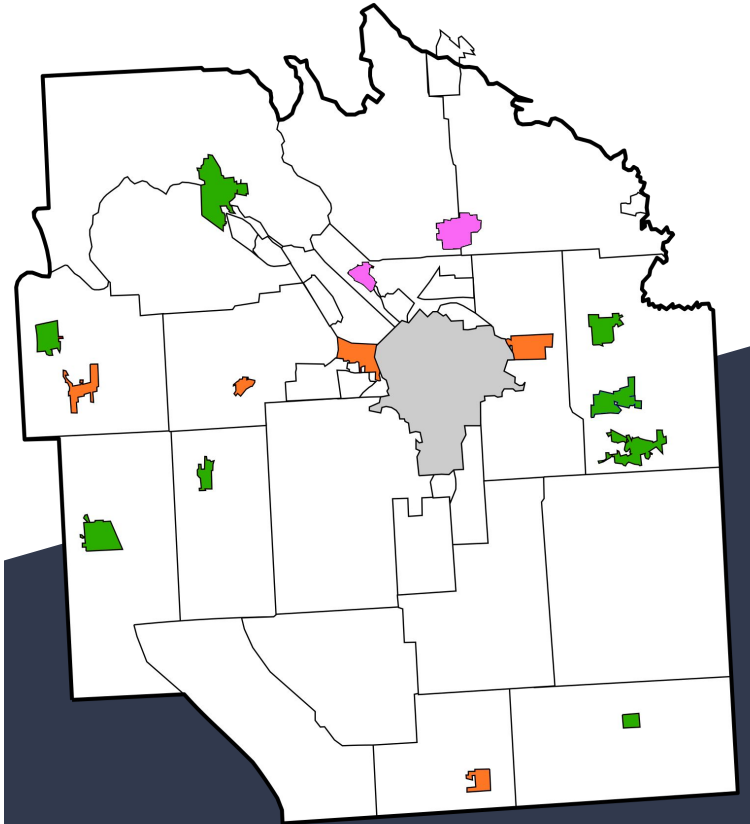
Village Boards can move their elections to November by putting a proposition on their ballot or residents can pass a petition to put the proposition on their ballot.

Who manages Village Elections?

- The Onondaga County Board of Elections manages 10 of the 15 village elections.
- 5 villages manage their own elections:
 - Fabius, Jordan, Liverpool, Marcellus and Skaneateles

What are the term lengths?

- 13 villages have 4 year terms.
- Fabius & Liverpool have 2 year terms.



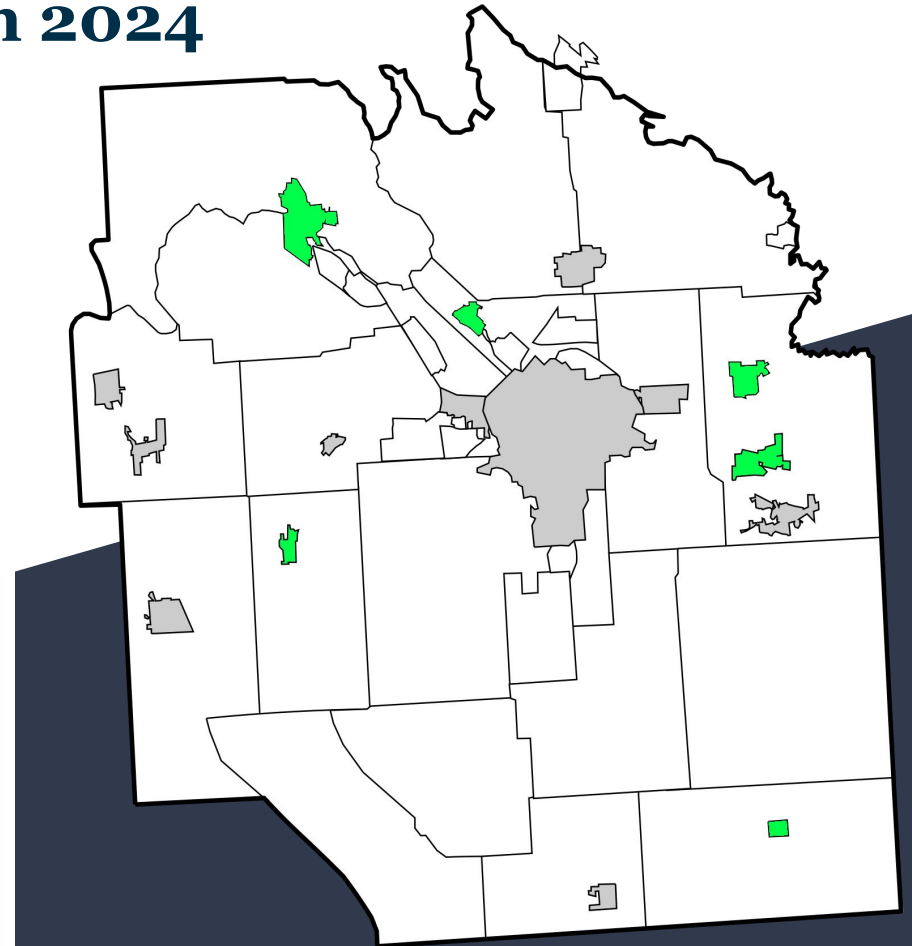

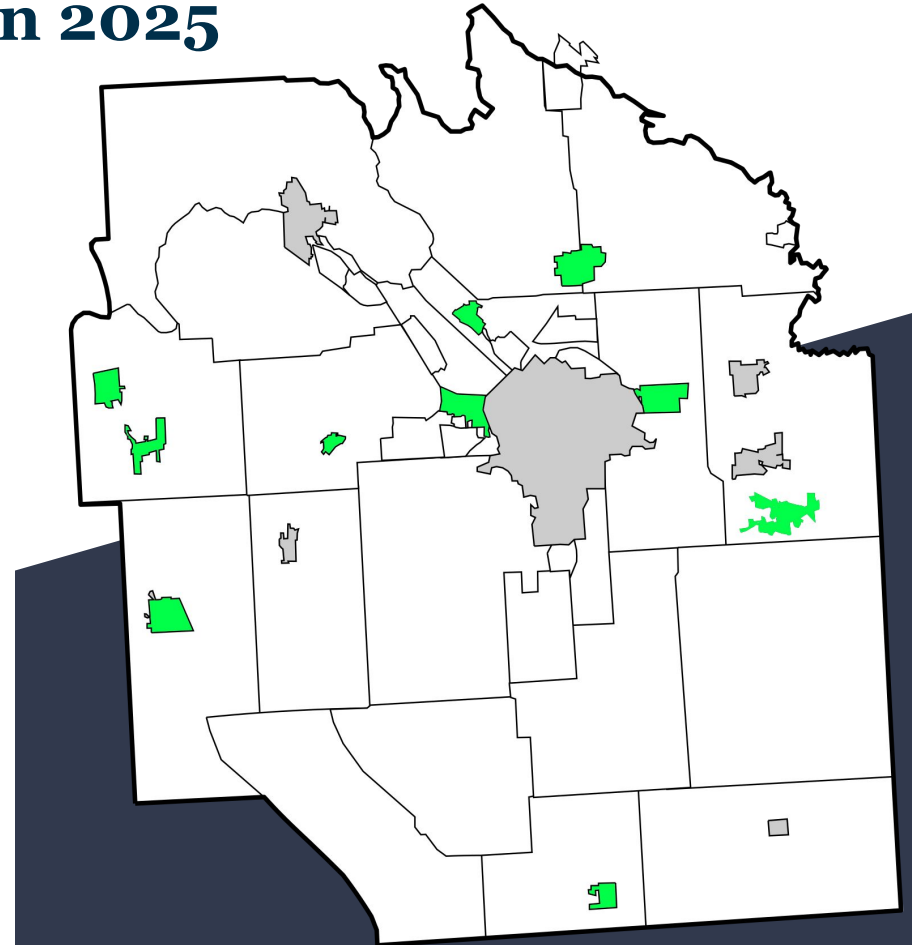

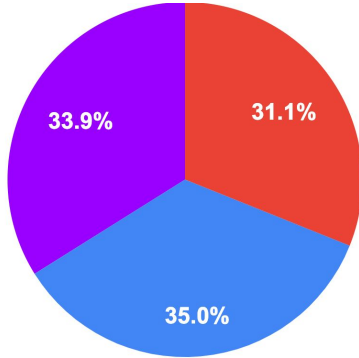
Registered Voters in Villages (as of June 2023)



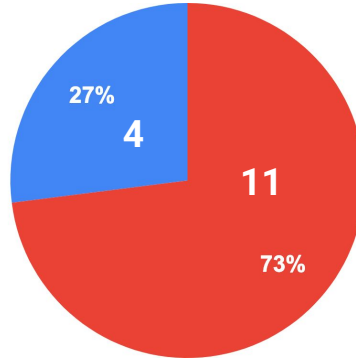
Onondaga County Village Elected Officials by Party

All Village Registered Voters

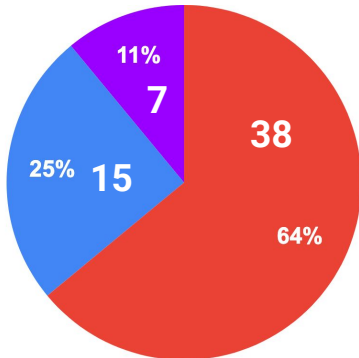

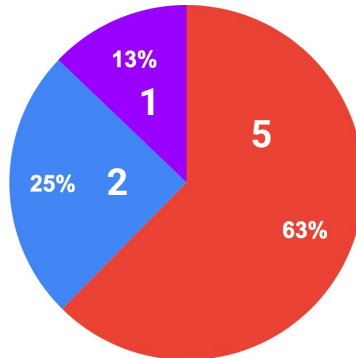


When we compare the registered voters who live in a village in Onondaga County to party affiliations of current village elected officials, we need to work on electing more representative village governments.

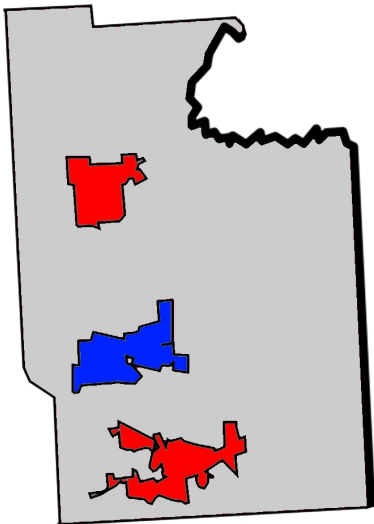
All Village Trustees

*Only 8 of the 15 villages have an elected justice



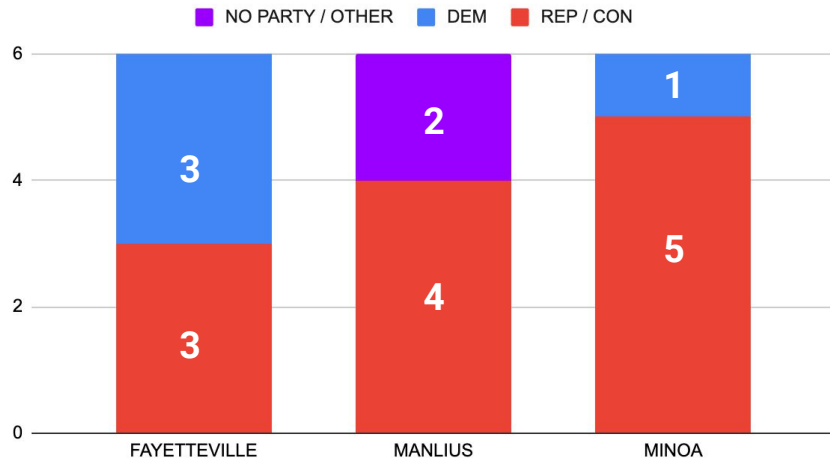
A Closer Look at the Villages of Fayetteville, Manlius & Minoa

Of the 83 elected positions in Onondaga County villages, 18 are in the villages of Fayetteville, Manlius & Minoa.

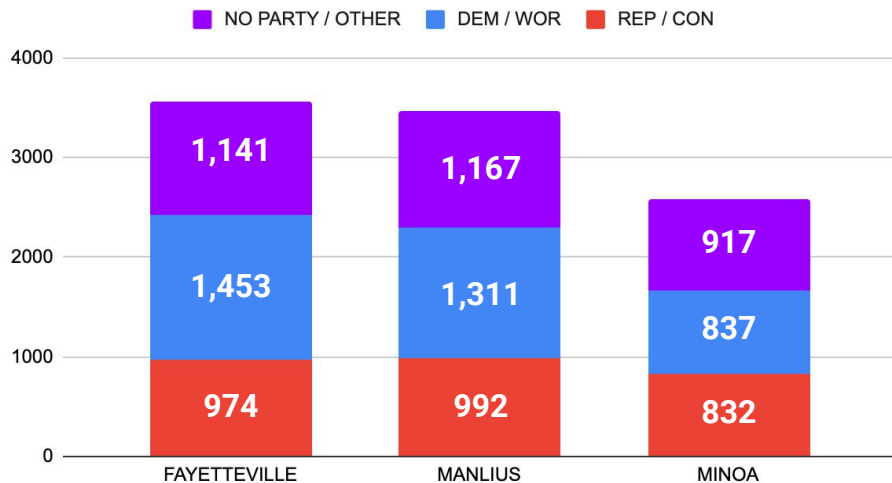
All 3 mayors are registered Republicans.

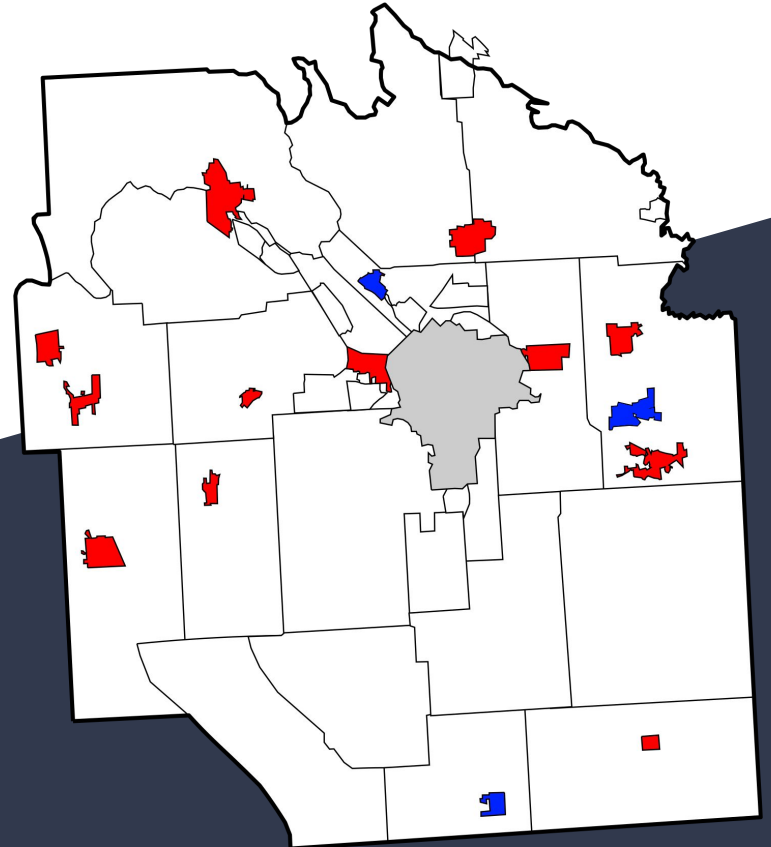


Registered Village Voters (June 2023)
